## MINORITY-SERVING INSTITUTION (MSI) STATUS JULY 2021 UPDATE

The Minority Serving Institution (MSI) classification enables institutions to improve and expand their capacity to serve specific populations. Several funding agencies give priority to MSI institutions. There are eight federally designated Minority Serving Institution (MSI) classifications for institutions of higher education. The only two classifications for which Hunter is eligible are:

**Asian Pacific Islander-Serving Institutions  
Hispanic Serving Institutions**
