PSC-CUNY GRANT PROGRAM

The online application system for PSC-CUNY cycle 45 is now open and can be found on the Research Foundation website at the following link <https://www.rfcuny.org/gp/welcome.aspx>.

Applicants may only apply for one of the three award types in any given year.

- Traditional A Awards: up to \$3,500
- Traditional B Awards: up to \$6,000
- Enhanced Awards: up to \$12,000

ELIGIBILITY

Full-time members of the instructional staff and untenured faculty who are on the regular University payroll processed through the Office of the Controller of the City or State of New York are eligible with the following exceptions:

- Visiting professors, substitutes and adjuncts are not eligible.
- If you are a tenured faculty member and have received a grant in both of the last two cycles (Cycle 43 and 44), you are not eligible to apply for any of the competitions this year.
- If you were previously awarded an Enhanced grant in the last two cycles (Cycle 43 and 44), you cannot apply for another Enhanced grant.
- If you have received external grant funding of \$100,000 direct costs or more for a research project, you are not eligible to apply for Traditional A or Traditional B competitions.

WORKSHOPS

The Hunter College Office of Research Administration will have two PSC-CUNY workshops.

- The first workshop will provide participants with a birds-eye view from the point of the reviewers. Hunter College faculty who serve on review panels will be presenters. The workshop will cover pitfalls, common errors, and what makes an application outstanding. It will be held on Tuesday, November 19, 2013, 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.
